Superintendent's News

Each school year I choose a word to focus my improvement efforts. I got this idea from Jon Gordon's book One Word That Will Change Your Life. I mentioned in our back-to-school newsletter that my word this year is "intentional." Sitting around the Thanksgiving table, I was thinking about how this word applies to being grateful. Being thankful is not a matter of circumstance, it is a matter of choice. We need to be intentional about being grateful.

There are plenty of negatives in our lives: the looming water rights issue, political divisiveness, not enough rain, too much snow, etc. If we choose to dwell on these negatives, we will just become more negative.

We have a lot of positive things going on in our community: a new grocery store and pharmacy, new restaurants in town, and school enrollment has increased by 13 kids over the last two months. If we are intentional about our focus on the good things, we will only be more positive. We must still face those challenges; we cannot ignore them. But it is nearly impossible to be stressed and grateful at the same time.

The thing I am most thankful for are the people around me. We have community events in both St. John and Hudson put on by many volunteers. Key leaders in elected positions or on volunteer boards are working to make things better. We have a great staff in our district who work in the best interest of kids every day. We have our challenges in the community and in our district. But the people are what make our school district and our community great.

Another thing I am thankful for is the supportive families here in our district. A few weeks ago, we held parent-teacher conferences. At the conferences, 92% of our students had a parent that participated. Our typical turnout is around 80%-85%.

Our district has been awarded a grant to implement a Parents as Teachers program. The goal of the Parents as Teachers (PAT) program is to provide parents with child development knowledge and parenting support, provide early detection of developmental delays and health issues, and increase children's school readiness. The PAT model includes one-on-one home visits, monthly group meetings, developmental screenings, and linkages and connections for families to needed resources.

Johnna Stanford is our new PAT director and Carol Siefkes is the PAT educator. The program will officially start after the holiday break. Keep an eye out for more information this month if you would like to participate in the program.

As the year draws to an end, many of you are considering charitable donations. You might consider the USD 350 Educational Foundation for any charitable giving. The Foundation is a non-profit organization that provides an avenue for patrons, businesses, and organizations to financially support to the mission of St. John-Hudson schools.

Our Foundation really captures the giving spirit of this great community. The Foundation accepts donations to support student scholarships, library funding, and various student and school programs. Donations can be given for a particular purpose or to be used at the discretion of the Foundation board to support our schools. Recently the Foundation provided classroom grants for robotics, pottery wheels for the art department, and a laser engraver for the industrial arts classes. 
