

1A Cross Country Regional Results for St. John

The St. John Cross Country team competed at the 1A Cross Country Regional hosted by Wichita East on Saturday. The regional is one of three regionals at the 1A level. The meet was run at the Cessna Activity Center in Wichita. The course included some rolling hills and the day was cool with a slight wind.

Thirteen teams and 87 runners competed in the boys' race. St. John placed all five runners in the top 20 to win the regional with a team score of 25 and to earn their fourth straight trip to State. Berean Academy was the runner-up with a score of 53. The Tiger team was led by A.J. Miller with a 2nd place finish and a time of 17:30.12. Wrangler Walker was 5th (18:24.26), Cashe McVey 9th (18:35.16), Trey Fisher 14th (18:47.99), Uriel Calleros 19th (18:58.63), Hunter Hanson 22nd (19:21.49) and Mason Osborne 29th (19:49.44). "I was happy with the way our boys competed today. We had some guys step up. Our boys will be excited to get our legs under us this week and to get ready to make another trip to state." Coach Delp

Jaden Reed competed in the girls division against 63 other girls. She finished 43rd with a time of 26:41.62. "Jaden ran one of her best races of the year today. I am very proud of the way she competed this year." Coach Delp

The boys' team will travel to the Wamego Country Club in Wamego Saturday for the 1A State Cross Country meet. The boys will run at 12:20.
