

# St. John-Hudson Schools - School Operations Quick Guide

## Calendar—First Day of School

The first day of school for students is August 27th. The updated calendar is available on our website.



## In-School Learning

Our goal is to have on-site instruction for all students as much as possible with increased health and safety measures to help prevent disease spread.



## Health and Safety

- Social distancing measures
- Frequent hand washing
- Increased cleaning

- Students remain in stable groups as much as possible
- Outside activities frequently

## Phased Approach

In cooperation with the county health department, the school environment will be determined by the level of disease spread in the community.

Risk Level	School
Low	In-Person
Moderate	Hybrid
High	Remote

## Health and Safety

- Parents required to take temperatures daily before school (must be lower than 99.6).
- Masks required for staff and students in grades 5 and up when social distancing not possible.



## Athletics and Activities

- Will continue with increased safety measures
- Dependent on current risk level
- Subject to KSHSAA regulations and county health orders
- Remote learning students may participate.

## Remote Learning

Available to high risk students with health concerns or those who choose not to return to in-school learning. Requires an application, semester-long commitment, daily log required with parent signature, daily requirement of a **full school day**, district will provide technology device. Remote learning may be required for all students at some point during the year for short periods of time. Any remote learning will require a **full school schedule every day**.



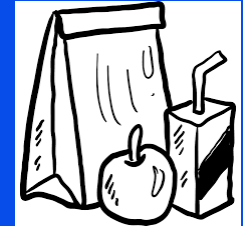
# School Operations Quick Guide (continued)

## Before School

- Doors open at 7:50am
- Students report directly to their classroom
- Temperature is taken by school staff upon arrival

## Breakfast

- Take-home breakfast only
- Students pick up a sacked breakfast to take home and eat the following day at home



## After School

- Staggered dismissal times
- 5th/6th east doors
- 1st/2nd grade south doors
- 3rd/4th grade southwest doors

## Lunch

- Served as normal while on-site
- Grade levels will eat in separate groups and areas
- Meals available for pickup for remote learners and if school is shut down

## Masks / Face Coverings

- Cloth face coverings are required for staff and students grades 5 and up, recommended for all grades
- School will provide masks or students may bring their own, elementary students should have their own mask they can wear to and from school



## Daily Screening

- Parents take temperature before sending to school. 99.6 or higher must stay home
- Answer NO to both: Been in close contact with COVID-19 within the last 14 days? Have any two symptoms?

## Transportation

- Masks required—students should bring their own
- Assigned seats
- Temps will be taken as students board the bus



## Visitors

- Only those necessary for school business
- Face coverings required
- Parents should call ahead to check out students
